The intent of this letter is to notify you that the Rice Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District has hired Northern Aquatic Services, an herbicide application company, to treat two species of non-native, invasive aquatic plant species – Curly-leaf pondweed (CLP) along the East Shore; and Hybrid water milfoil (HWM) - in the Clearwater Bay and South Basin area of Rice Lake. The Wisconsin DNR has issued a permit to treat roughly 17.8 acres. The Trade Name herbicide to be used for CLP is “Aquathol K”, for HWM it is “ProcellaCOR”. Both herbicides have been labeled for aquatic use by the Environmental Protection Agency. Any water usage restrictions for the treated area will be posted on yellow signs in the treated areas.




Figure 1: CLP management along the East Shore (brown) and HWM management in Clearwater Bay and the South Basin (black)
